

50 Years of Indiana Folk Music, 1938-1988

Field Collections in the Archives of Traditional Music

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As the State of Indiana marks its bicentennial year in 2016, this folklorist was moved to highlight the artistic contributions of folk musicians from his native state by reviewing pertinent holdings in the Archives of Traditional Music (ATM). And with the approaching bicentennial of Indiana University in 2020, it behooves me to frame that review within the rich history of interaction between Hoosiers and their university, through the fieldwork conducted by several generations of folklorists and ethnomusicologists associated with the ATM and the Department of Folklore and Ethnomusicology.

The resulting index covers a half century worth of field recording within Indiana's borders, comprising 268 collections. This document begins with a list of collections, arranged by collector. That list is followed by a map of Indiana counties containing year designations, each hyperlinked to a summary description of the designated collection. The culminating list of collection summaries is ordered by the year(s) during which field recordings were made. The following sample shows the information contained in the summary descriptions.

1988 *County:* Home county of the artist; or, if multiple artists, county where recorded
Acc#: Accession No. Artist; (&c.) Hometown of the artist; or recording location
Key: Collection Key Ethnicity
Type: music genre(s); identification of event or recording location, as needed

Catalogued collections in the Archives of Traditional Music are each given a unique accession number. Accession numbers begin with the last two digits of the year in which the collection was deposited at the ATM. An accession number does not disclose the provenance of the recordings contained in the collection, nor the identities of the participants. To better comprehend the human interactions that constitute recording folk music in the field, I have assigned each collection a key comprised of the primary collector's last name and a two-digit indicator of the year in which the fieldwork or recording took place. Successive field recording sessions by the same collector in the same year are identified by adding a lower case letter and, if needed, an additional integer. In the master list of collections, keys are each linked directly to a

summary description. On the map of counties, a year or span of years is linked to a single collection. Year indications followed by a decimal are linked to contemporaneous collections made in that county by different collectors. A collection that covers multiple counties is linked on the map from each county. A handful of collections, from unspecified locations, are not linked to the map.

The use of the collection key also enabled for the inclusion of a number of collections held in the Archives's vaults that have not yet been catalogued (Brose 81, March 76, and Tyler 76, 81, 82, 83, 85, 86, and 88). Accession numbers for these collections are forthcoming, though inclusion of all is conditional upon deposit agreements with the collectors.

The majority of the collections included in this index are of field recordings that were made at one location, on one occasion, with a single or small set of artists or interviewees. A small portion of the collections include recordings from several proximate occasions with the same artists, or within the same county, or with artists grouped by event or some other factor. A few accession numbers refer to larger collections that encompass multiple artists, locations, and occasions. For greater geographical, chronological, and personal specificity, a few of these larger complexes grouped under a single accession number have been divided into multiple key designations: i.e., Lomax 38a (54-155-F) comprises six discrete collections in this index, Tyler 86-87 (86-677-F) contains eleven, and from Munn 52 (61-069-F) I have identified four separated topical investigations in which music was discussed or performed. The Patrick Dunford collection (78-150-F), for which the documentation lacks any kind of chronological arrangement, has also been divided into seventeen discrete collections grouped by artists and chronology, where possible. Similar treatment was given to Art Rosenbaum's collections contained in accession numbers 70-110-F through 70-120-F, yielding four additional collection keys.

The curatorial scope of this array of collections will be treated in a forthcoming analysis to be published separately. Some important preliminary qualifications are that this project was interested in field collections, which are executed through personal interaction between the collector and the musicians recorded. Home recordings or community recordings that eventually found their way to the ATM were also included, because in most cases there is a traceable interaction between a folklorist or the ATM staff and the musicians or their families. For instance, the Lovell collection was deposited in 1980 through my interactions with Doris Lovell of Winchester, Indiana. For the most part, commercial recordings were excluded from consideration, with the few exceptions being early country music radio broadcasts that were

dubbed for me by musicians I interviewed: e.g., Sam Devincent, Everett “Shorty” Cook, Bob Homan, and Joe Taylor, all active at one time on radio in Fort Wayne.

The aim of this project was to be inclusive, to work with a generous understanding of what it means to be from Indiana , as well as with a broad concept of folk music. Such generosity led to adding several field recordings made in Bloomington of singers or musicians who may have been students from elsewhere, and thus only temporary residents of Indiana. Also, collections were included if the event recorded took place in Indiana for Hoosiers, though the musicians who performed were from outside Indiana: e.g., Bradunas 75, Brose 81d to 81e, and Tyler 83a and 85a. Defining folk music has always been a contentious affair, but this project strove for inclusion of both amateur and professional (or semi-professional) musicians, though their commercial products were not indexed. No distinction was made between authentic and revival folk musicians, though the folk revival phenomenon—which involves the adoption of a community-based music tradition by musicians not part of that community—presents critical challenges for the future expansion of this project to material collected after 1988.

Finally, the temporal scope of a half century should be explained. It is relatively easy to fix the starting date for this review of Indiana field collections in the ATM. The first sound recordings of Indiana folk musicians were made by Alan and Elizabeth Lomax in 1938. The end date of 1988 was suggested through initial searches for ‘folk music’ or ‘ethnic music’ and ‘Indiana’ in the Indiana University library’s online catalog (IUCAT). A change in local collecting activities and institutional arrangements seems to have occurred in the decade of the 1990s. The last quarter century of field collecting in Indiana deserve equal attention. But it also presents new challenges, due in large part to technological changes in the recording and distribution of music. Once again, this is left for a later expansion of this index.

Two tangible factors led to the present determination to concentrate on the 50 years from 1938 to 1988. First, at least 40 accessioned collections from this period are not found in IUCAT. Most of these collections were first deposited in the Folklore Archive and later transferred to the ATM. Secondly, as mentioned above, this project identified a large cache of recordings from the 1970s and ‘80s that have not yet been fully accessioned into the ATM’s holdings. It seemed appropriate to bring focus to this narrower span of fieldwork and assist completion of the archival process for these collections. Thus, we have here a half century review of field recordings made in Indiana laying the ground work for future expansion into a project that comprehends a larger share of folk music from our two centuries of statehood.


